



Double Degree with The University of Queensland, Australia

The University of Queensland was founded in 1909 as the first university in the state of Queensland and is now ranked among the top 50 universities worldwide. The Law School is also the oldest law school in Queensland. Many of Australia's most distinguished legal scholars are alumni of this school, including Mrs Una Prentice, the Law School's first graduate and the first woman to be admitted to the Queensland bar. Today, the Law School is one of the leading law schools in Australia and worldwide. With small class sizes and state-of-the-art facilities in the building refurbished in 2016, the School offers excellent conditions for students, who—alongside their regular courses—can also participate in renowned moot court competitions and legal clinics

Number of Study Places:

The double degree master's program with The University of Queensland is limited to 4 study places per year.

Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 4.7 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years.

Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency must be demonstrated with one of the following language tests (subject to change):

- **TOEFL iBT (including Paper Edition):**
 - A minimum of 87 points «overall» with at least:
 - 19 (each) in the disciplines of listening, reading and speaking
 - 21 in the discipline of writing
- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS):**
 - Min. 6.5 «overall», with at least 6 in the disciplines of reading, writing, speaking, listening
- **PTE Academic:**
 - Overall Score of 64 and 60 in all sub bands
- **Cambridge English Scale (CES)**
 - Overall score 176 and 169 in all sub bands

The University of Queensland does not accept certificates from the Occupational English Test (OET).

Please note that language certificates must **not be older than two years at the time of starting studies at The University**

of Queensland, and therefore not older than one year at the time of applying for the double degree program at RWF UZH.
