



# Double Degree with the University of Edinburgh, United Kingdom

Edinburgh Law School is located in the historic Old College, a beautiful and historically significant campus in the heart of Edinburgh. The Law School is a world-leading law faculty and has been in existence for over 300 years. The wide range of LL.M and M.Sc programs on offer allows students to deepen their knowledge in their area of interest at one of the most prestigious law schools.

## Important Note:

The study program at the University of Edinburgh is demanding and offers an intensive academic experience, comprising 60 ECTS of coursework and an LL.M dissertation worth 30 ECTS (approximately 35–40 pages) to be completed within two semesters. The dissertation may be submitted flexibly until the end of August. Dissertation results are released in late September.

## Number of Study Places:

The double degree master's program with the University of Edinburgh is limited to 10 study places. (There are also separate limitations for each specific study program in place.)

## Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 5.0 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years

## Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency must be demonstrated with one of the following language tests (subject to change):

- **Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL-iBT):**
  - A minimum of 100 points with a minimum of 25 in writing and 23 in all the other disciplines.
- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS Academic)\*:**
  - A minimum of 7.0 «overall» with a minimum of 7.0 in writing and a minimum of 6.5 in all the other disciplines.
- **C1 Advanced (CAE) / C2 Proficiency (CPE):**
  - A minimum of 185 in total with a minimum of 185 in writing and 176 in all the other disciplines
- **Trinity ISE:**
  - ISE III with passes in all four components.
- **Oxford ELLT:**
  - total 8 with at least 8 in writing and 7 in all other components.
- **Oxford Test of English Advanced:**
  - total 155 with at least 155 in writing and 145 in all other components.

*\*The UoE does not accept IELTS One Skill Retake.*

Please note that **TOEFL/IELTS/ /Trinity ISE/Oxford ELLT/Oxford Test of English Advanced certificates must be no older than 2 years, and CAE/CPE certificates no older than 3.5 years**, at the start of studies at the partner university.
