



# Double Degree with Doshisha University, Japan

Doshisha University is a private university full of history, located in Kyoto Prefecture, a city rich in world heritage sites and Japan's cultural center. The institution is committed to the following three basic teaching philosophies: the Christian faith, free thought and an international outlook.

## Number of Study Places:

The Double Degree Master's Program with Doshisha University is limited to 5 study places.

## Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 4.7 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years

## Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency must be demonstrated with one of the following language tests (subject to change):

- **Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL):**
  - Minimum requirement of 79 points in the internet-based test
- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS):**
  - The minimum requirement is 6.0 «overall»

*Doshisha University **does not accept** IELTS One Skill Retake or TOEFL iBT MyBest Scores. They will also no longer accept IELTS Online or TOEFL iBT Home Edition*

Please note that language certificates must **not be older than two years at the time of starting studies at the Partner Faculty**, and therefore not older than one year at the time of applying for the Double Degree Program at RWF UZH.

## Language:

Courses and examinations at the Doshisha University are held in English.

## Study Programs:

The Double Degree study programs offered by RWF UZH can be combined with the "Master of Laws (LL.M.)".

Please note that the **Master's thesis at UZH** in the Double Degree Programme with Doshisha University **must be written in English**, independent of the study program at UZH.

## Degrees:

Master of Law UZH from the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich (RWF UZH) and Master of Laws from the Graduate School of Law of Doshisha University.
