



Double Degree with the Chicago Kent College of Law, USA

Chicago-Kent College of Law is the law school of the Illinois Institute of Technology, a private research university in Chicago. Chicago-Kent is located within the downtown Chicago Loop, blocks away from the city's courthouses, government centers and countless law firms, and within walking distance of the city's nightlife and restaurant district. Chicago-Kent places a special focus on teaching foundational skills as well as practical skills training, for example through legal clinics.

Number of Study Places:

No limitation of study places in the double degree master's program with the Chicago Kent College of Law.

Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 4.7 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years

Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency must be demonstrated with one of the following language tests (subject to change):

- **Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL):**
 - With a minimum of 90/120 points
- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS)*:**
 - min. 7.0 «overall»

**The Chicago-Kent College of Law may, in certain cases, waive the requirement for an English certificate based on an English proficiency interview.*

Tuition Fees at the Chicago Kent College of Law:

\$20'000 USD for the whole LL.M. (the regular study fees for the LL.M. are \$44'000 USD; UZH students receive a scholarship of \$24'000 USD)

Study Fees for the academic year 2025/2026, subject to change.

Duration of Studies:

2 Semesters at RWF UZH

2 Semesters at the Chicago Kent College of Law

Language:

Courses and examinations at the Chicago Kent College of Law are held in English.

Study Programs:
