Master's thesis agreement

The legal bases for the Master's thesis are the Framework Ordinances (RVO RWF), the Study Regulations and the Fact Sheet on Assessments.

The Master's thesis comprises 12 ECTS credits, is considered a compulsory module and is graded. The supervisor determines the framework conditions that apply to the writing of the master's thesis.

According to § 39 RVO RWF, the master's thesis may only be started in the master's program. By signing the agreement, the student confirms that he or she is enrolled in the Master's program. It should be noted that a master's thesis brought forward in the bachelor's program cannot be credited.
