



Double Degree with the University of Johannesburg, South Africa

The University of Johannesburg is located in the vibrant, multicultural and dynamic capital of South Africa. The University of Johannesburg's Law School is committed to ensuring that its graduates are able to participate meaningfully and effectively in current legal and political debates. Since 1981, the Law School offers a "Law Clinic", which provides free legal services.

Number of Study Places:

No limitation of study places in the double degree master's program with the University of Johannesburg.

Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 4.7 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years.

Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency must be demonstrated with one of the following language tests (subject to change):

- **Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL):**
 - The Minimum requirement is 110 points «overall».
- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS):**
 - Minimum requirement is 7.0 «overall».

Please note that language certificates must **not be older than two years at the time of starting studies at the partner faculty**, and therefore not older than one year at the time of applying for the double degree master's program at RWF UZH.
