



# Double Degree with King's College London, The Dickson Poon School of Law, United Kingdom

King's College London, located in the center of London, is one of the top British universities. It offers an international outlook and enables students to familiarize themselves with the basic principles of the Anglo-American legal system.

## Number of Study Places:

The double degree master's program with the King's College London is limited to 20 study places.

## Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 5.0 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years.

## Special Admission Requirements:

All candidates are required to provide proof that they have met the requisite Band B English language requirement; this includes EU, EEA, and Swiss students. Please note that language certificates must **not be older than two years at the time of starting studies at the partner faculty**, and therefore not older than one year at the time of applying for the double degree master's program at RWF UZH.
