2. Presentations

The presentations should be around 10 minutes. If your presentation lasts more than 15 minutes, you will be asked to conclude. Then a short discussion will take place. The participation of the other students during this second part is mandatory and will be taken into account for the final mark.

A program with the running order will be sent about two weeks before.

The use of slides is recommended. For time reasons, please send the slides by **30 May** at the latest.

3. Grades

The grade will be given on two criteria:

- **33% for the participation in class**
- **66% for the presentation**

The students who are absent during the two-day presentations without legitimate reasons will be given the grade of 1.
