



# Double Degree with the Universiteit Maastricht, The Netherlands

Maastricht University is a renowned Dutch university with a strong international orientation. The Master's program is particularly aimed at students with an interest in International and European law issues.

## Number of Study Places:

There is no limitation of study places within the double degree master's program with Maastricht University.

An exception is the study program "Forensics, Criminology and Law", where a **maximum of 5 study places** are available.

## Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 4.7 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years.

## Special Admission Requirements:

None.

## Tuition Fees at the Universiteit van Amsterdam:

EUR 2'695 per year (Fees for the academic year 2026/2027, subject to change)

## Duration of Studies:

2 Semesters at RWF UZH

2 Semesters at Universiteit Maastricht

## Language:

Courses and examinations at Maastricht University are held in English.
