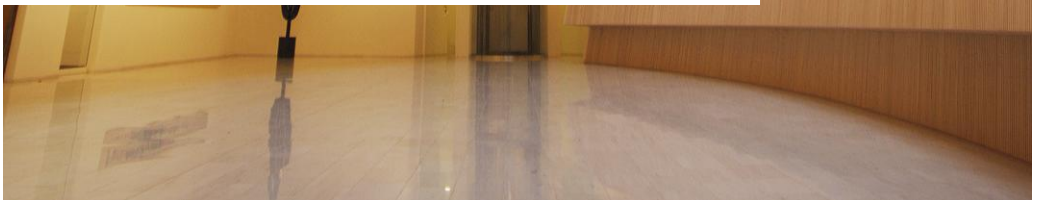


Reinsurance to the Rescue: Tackling the Insurance Protection Gap

Prof. Karel Van Hulle lectures as emeritus professor at the Economics and Business Faculty of the KU Leuven. He is honorary professor of the Goethe University in Frankfurt, and fellow of the International Centre of Insurance Regulation. He is a non-executive member of the Board of

the Bermuda Monetary Authority and Chairman of the Conflicts of Interest Oversight Committee of the European Money Markets Institute, and he served as head of insurance and pensions at the European Commission.

The recent fires in California have shown again the importance of insurance as a means to protect private individuals and businesses against catastrophic risks. This public lecture will discuss how to address the present growing insurance protection gap, with particular emphasis on the role of reinsurance. The presentation will be followed by a panel discussion with experts from the (re)insurance industry, from supervision and from academia.
